3 Years in State Prison for Attempted Robbery



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that RAYMEIR WORTHEN, 19, of Albany, was sentenced to 3 years in State Prison, to be followed by 1 ½

years of Post Release Supervision before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On June 20, 2013, WORTHEN pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony.

On April 28, 2013 in the area of North Lake Avenue and Livingston Avenue in the City of Albany, WORTHEN approached an individual displaying a knife and demanded the victim empty out his pockets. WORTHEN took two cellphones from the victim and was aided by two unidentified accomplices.

WORTHEN is currently incarcerated in a New York State Prison stemming from an unrelated previous conviction.

“It’s a shame that at the age of 19 Mr. Worthen is going to state prison. Despite having opportunities to correct his behavior and his trajectory, he chose to perpetrate more crime and now he will have to suffer the consequences of those choices,” commented District Attorney Soares.

Assistant District Attorney Linda Griggs of the Major Offense Bureau handled the prosecution of this case.
