Albany Man Sentenced for Violating No Contact Order of Protection



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ROBERT JETT, 42, of Albany, was sentenced to 6 months in the Albany County Correctional Facility, to be followed by 5 years of Felony Probation, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On November 21, 2013, JETT pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Aggravated Criminal Contempt, a Class D Felony.

On October 10, 2013 at a residence in the City of Albany, the defendant caused multiple physical injuries to an individual known to him by hitting the victim with a broom in the arm and wrist and squeezing the victim's neck.

The defendant was in full violation of a No Contact Order of Protection issued by the Honorable William Carter in Albany City Court on May 16, 2012.

In addition to the 6 month period of incarceration and 5 years of Felony Probation, the defendant will also be required to be enrolled in a domestic violence batterer's intervention program.

Assistant District Attorney Jennifer McCanney of the Special Victims Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
