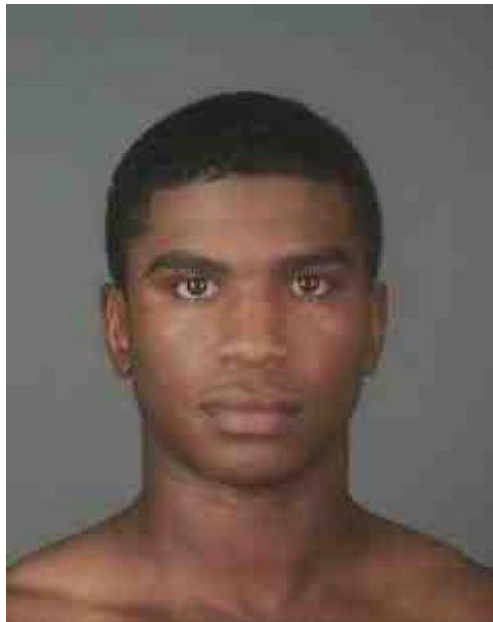

## Albany Teenager Sentenced to 5 Years in State Prison for Residential Burglary



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **SHAQUAN GILLENWATER**, 18, of Albany, was sentenced to 5 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Andrew Ceresia in the Supreme Court of Albany County this morning.

On September 11, 2013, GILLENWATER pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony. This guilty plea is in full satisfaction of several residential burglaries in the City of Albany that have been attributed to this defendant.

On August 8, 2013 on Western Avenue in the City of Albany, GILLENWATER and two co-defendants unlawfully entered a residence and while inside stole a laptop and various electronic devices.

GILLENWATER's co-defendants have each pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree and are awaiting sentencing.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Offense Bureau is overseeing the prosecution of this case.
