Assault with 2 x 4 Leads to 3 Years in State Prison for Albany Man



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **ROBERT BARTON**, 48, of Albany, was sentenced to 3 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision before the Honorable Roger McDonough in the Supreme Court of Albany County on July 31, 2013.

On July 3, 2013, BARTON pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony.

On April 16, 2013, BARTON went to the residence of a woman who is known to him on Washington Avenue in the city of Albany. BARTON attempted to contact her despite there being a No Contact Order of Protection previously issued by the Honorable William A. Carter of Albany City Court.

On April 21, 2013, BARTON went back the residence. When BARTON saw the individual outside of the residence, he grabbed a 2 x 4 piece of wood and repeatedly struck the victim in the arm, neck and leg. The victim required medical attention as a result of the assault.

Assistant District Attorney Carmen Warner of the Special Victims Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
