Co-Defendants Arraigned for Roles in the Murder of Edward Maxim

ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JAHMEEK CROLEY, 26, of Albany, and JOVELL WHITE-SPAN, 22, of Rensselaer, were each arraigned for their alleged roles in a October 2013 homicide in the City of Albany.

JOVELL WHITE-SPAN was arraigned on (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-I Felony, and (1) Count of Conspiracy in the Second Degree, a Class B Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

JAHMEEK CROLEY was arraigned on (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-I Felony, and (1) Count of Conspiracy in the Second Degree, a Class B Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

The indictment alleges on October 19, 2013 in the area of Cortland Place in the City of Albany, JAHMEEK CROLEY and JOVELL WHITE-SPAN caused the death of Edward Maxim by means of shooting him with a pistol. The indictment further alleges the both co-defendants conspired to commit the crime of Murder in the Second Degree.

JAHMEEK CROLEY pleaded not guilty to all charges and was remanded in lieu of bail to the Albany County Correctional Facility.

JOVELL WHITE-SPAN pleaded not guilty to all charges and was remanded in lieu of bail back to the Rensselaer County Correctional Facility.

Chief Assistant District Attorney David Rossi is handling the prosecution of this case.
