Colonie Man Arraigned for Repeatedly Failing to File State Income Taxes



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that GREGORY FOLAND, 46, of Colonie, was arraigned on (1) Count of Repeated Failure to File Personal Income Tax Returns for Three Consecutive Tax Years, a Class E Felony, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

The indictment alleges that during 2005, 2006 and 2007 the defendant did not pay New York State income tax in violation of New York State Tax Law.

FOLAND pleaded not guilty and was remanded to the Albany County Correctional Facility in lieu of bail. The People attempted to have the defendant arraigned on these charges yesterday morning, however, FOLAND was held in contempt of Court for failing to adequately answer questions concerning his identity. Following the arraignment this morning the defendant is no longer being held in contempt of Court.

FOLAND faces up to 1 1/3 to 4 years in State Prison if convicted.

Assistant District Attorney Benjamin Clark of the Financial Crimes Unit is prosecuting this case.
