Crack Cocaine Sale Leads to State Prison



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **TREVON JOHNSON**, 36, of Albany, was sentenced to 5 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 Years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in the Supreme Court of Albany County.

On October 22, 2012, **JOHNSON** pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class C Felony.

On July 3, 2012, JOHNSON was observed by police selling crack cocaine. When police moved in to arrest him, JOHNSON fled in his car but crashed into a police vehicle in the process. The defendant then fled on foot but was apprehended shortly after.

Assistant District Attorney Kurt Haas of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
