## Defendant Arraigned on Multiple Violent Felonies Stemming from Colonie Police Standoff



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **TIMOTHY ANATRIELLO JR.**, 24, of Colonie, was arraigned on (1) Count of Kidnapping in the Second Degree, a Class B Felony, (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony, (1) Count of Coercion in the First Degree, a Class D Felony, (1) Count of Strangulation in the Second

Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Fourth Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor, (1) Count of Reckless Endangerment in the Second Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor and (1) Count of Menacing a Police Officer or Peace Officer, a Class D Violent Felony.

The indictment alleges that on December 20, 2013 at a residence on Consaul Road in the Town of Colonie, the defendant allegedly abducted an individual known to him and physically assaulted the victim multiple times.

When officers from the Colonie Police Department arrived at the scene, the defendant allegedly appeared outside the residence with a rifle and menaced nearby police officers by aiming the weapon in their direction.

ANATRIELLO pleaded not guilty to all charges and was remanded to the Albany County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$50,000 bail.

Assistant District Attorney Brett Knowles of the Special Victims Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
