Defendant Pleads Guilty to Driving Drunk on Interstate 90



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **ROBERTO LIVINGSTON**, 40, of Schenectady, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a

Class E Felony, before the Honorable Thomas A. Breslin in the Supreme Court of Albany County this morning.

On April 15, 2013 on Interstate 90 in the Town of Guilderland, the defendant was observed by two New York State Police Troopers driving his vehicle 25mph over the speed limit. Upon the initiation of a traffic stop, the defendant failed to immediately pull over and continued to drive for several minutes until finally pulling the vehicle over.

Once the vehicle stopped, the Troopers observed the defendant exhibiting multiple physical signs of intoxication, including glassy eyes, impaired speech and detected the smell of alcoholic beverages coming from the defendant's breath. The defendant failed multiple field sobriety tests and refused to submit to a chemical test while in police custody.

LIVINGSTON faces 1 to 3 years in State Prison, the installation of an Ignition Interlock Device for 3 years following his release, a \$1,000 fine and license revocation when sentenced on February 20, 2014.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Peluso of the Financial Crimes Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
