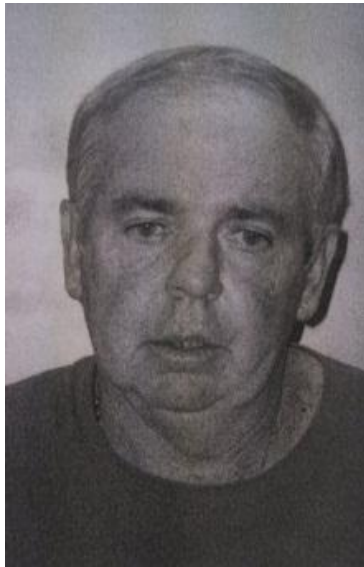

Defendant Sentenced for Felony Driving While Intoxicated



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that PETER KILMER, 56, of Ravena, was sentenced to 10 months in the Albany County Correctional Facility, to be followed by 5 years of Felony Probation before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On February 4, 2014, KILMER pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Class E Felony.

On September 20, 2013 on Interstate 87 in the Town of Guilderland, members of the New York State Police stopped the defendant's vehicle for driving 82 miles per hour in a 55 miles per hour work zone. Upon stopping the vehicle, officers observed the defendant exhibiting multiple physical signs of intoxication as they spoke with him.

After failing multiple field sobriety tests, the defendant was taken into custody where he registered a BAC of .17%.

The Court also imposed a minimum of 1 year of license revocation, a \$1,000 fine and required the defendant to install an Ignition Interlock Device for 5 years following his release from custody.

This case was prosecuted by Vehicular Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter.
