Delmar Man Sentenced to 4 Years in State Prison for Burglary



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that FRANK MARKUS, 50, of Delmar, was sentenced to 4 years in State Prison as a Second Felony Offender, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On November 11, 2013, MARKUS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony.

On October 10, 2013, the defendant took a taxi to Wormer Road in the Town of Guilderland and entered a residence through an unlocked front door. While inside, the defendant stole a jar containing small bills and loose change that totaled \$150.00.

As the defendant took the jar, he was encountered by the occupant of the residence, a 90 year old male. The defendant then left the residence and got back into the taxi and was driven to a Price Chopper where he was observed using the Coin Star machine to cash in the victim's loose change.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Offense Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
