Guilty Plea in Coeymans and Westerlo Burglaries



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ROBERT GIORDANO, 24, of Hannacroix, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in the Supreme Court of Albany County this morning.

On April 19, 2013, GIORDANO did unlawfully enter a residence in the Town of Coeymans and did steal jewelry, a jewelry box, a laptop computer and an air pellet gun. When the occupants of the residence discovered the missing items, they called the police department.

GIORDANO faces between 8 and 9 years in State Prison to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision as a Second Felony Offender on August 2, 2013. This guilty plea is in full satisfaction of several other burglaries attributed to this defendant, including two in the Town of Westerlo and an additional burglary in Coeymans.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Legal Affairs Bureau is handling the prosecution of this case.
