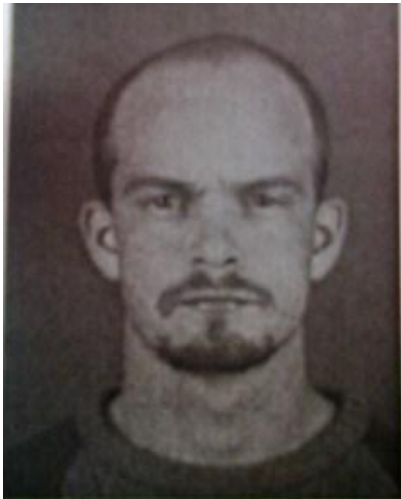

Major Offense Bureau Secures State Prison Sentences

ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KAREN SAYLOR, 41, of Albany, and PETER WILCOX, 30, of Colonie, were both sentenced on February 5, 2013 before the Honorable Joseph Teresi.

KAREN SAYLOR was sentenced to 5 years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision. On January 2, 2013, SAYLOR pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony.

Between June 26 and July 17, 2012, SAYLOR unlawfully entered six residences in the City of Albany near the areas of Irving Street, Jay Street, and Madison Avenue and stole personal property.

On July 17, during the commission of a burglary, SAYLOR was confronted by the occupant of the residence on Hudson Avenue and fled. SAYLOR was later positively identified by the occupant and a search warrant was issued for SAYLOR's residence, where a large number of the stolen items were located.

In an unrelated crime, PETER WILCOX was sentenced to 1 ½ to 3 years in State Prison after pleading guilty on January 2, 2013 to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Fourth Degree, a Class E Felony.

WILCOX, an employee of Father Peter Young Housing Industry and Treatment Facility, on two occasions stole equipment and tools from the facility and sold them for cash at a local pawn shop. WILCOX was on parole at the time of his arrest.

Assistant District Attorney Linda Griggs of the Major Offense Unit prosecuted both cases.
