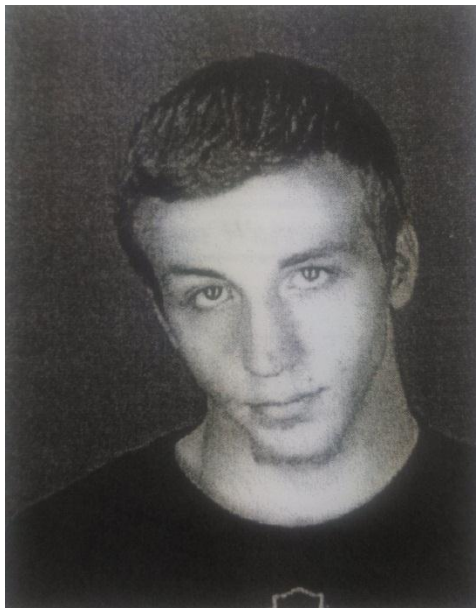

Massachusetts Teenager Sentenced to 4 Years in State Prison for Colonie Robbery



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **DYLAN MCCLURE**, 18, of Westfield, Massachusetts, was sentenced to 4 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court.

On July 25, 2013, MCCLURE pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony.

On September 26, 2012 at the Towers of Colonie Apartments on Sand Creek Road in the Town of Colonie, the victim, a pizza delivery man, approached MCCLURE with a pizza the defendant had ordered.

Upon giving MCCLURE the pizza, the defendant, along with an unidentified accomplice, repeatedly punched and kicked the victim and stole his wallet, money and a cell phone.

Assistant District Attorney Benjamin Mastaitis of the Major Offense Bureau handled the prosecution of this case.
