NYS Prison Inmate Pleads Guilty to Pawning Stolen Property in Colonie



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JOHN SUDDARD, 40, formerly of Fort Edward, NY, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of Stolen Property in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

The defendant was observed by New York State Police Investigators entering Old Saratoga Coin on Central Avenue in the Town of Colonie with property that the State Police Investigators knew was stolen. The defendant received \$3,388 for the stolen items and was arrested when he exited the store.

SUDDARD faces 3 ½ to 7 years in State Prison as a Predicate Felon when sentenced on February 13, 2014.

SUDDARD is currently incarcerated in the New York State Department of Corrections for numerous unrelated burglaries in Washington County.

Assistant District Attorney Linda Griggs of the Major Offense Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
