Sara Moore Arraigned on First Degree Murder Charges for Death of 79 Year Old Man



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that SARA MOORE, 35, of Wynantskill, was arraigned before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court this morning for allegedly robbing and murdering a 79 year old man at his residence on Woodside Drive in the City of Albany.

On April 4, 2014, an Albany County Grand Jury returned an indictment charging the defendant with (1) Count of Murder in the First Degree, a Class A-I Felony, (2) Counts of Murder in the

Second Degree, both Class A-I Felonies, and (1) Count of Robbery in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony.

The indictment alleges that on February 6, 2014 at a residence on Woodside Drive in the City of Albany, the defendant allegedly stole property from Richard Englander by means of force which caused the victim to sustain a serious physical injury. During the alleged robbery, the defendant did allegedly cause the death of the victim.

MOORE pleaded not guilty to all charges and was remanded back to the Albany County Correctional Facility in lieu of bail.

Special Victims Unit Bureau Chief Shannon Sarfoh and Financial Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Daniel Lynch are handling the prosecution of this case.
