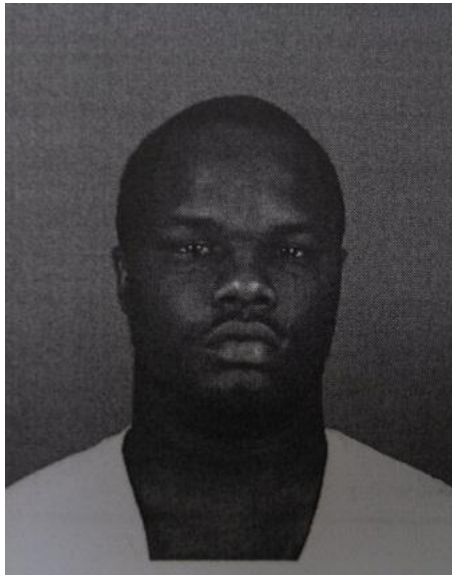

## State Prison for Gun Possession, Crack Cocaine Sale

**ALBANY, NY**- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JAHRELL FRIDAY, 25, of Albany, and KIERRA TERRELL, 19, of Schenectady, were sentenced to State Prison this morning before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

FRIDAY was sentenced to 4 years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision. On April 23, 2013, FRIDAY pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class C Felony.

TERRELL was sentenced to 2 ½ years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision. On April 23, 2013, TERRELL pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony.

On September 19, 2012, a search warrant was executed by members of the Albany Police Department at a residence on Hudson Avenue in the City of Albany. When officers entered the residence, both FRIDAY and TERRELL were inside, and after a search officers did find a loaded 9mm handgun with 12 rounds of live ammunition.

The handgun was reported stolen from an individual living in Vermont. Upon a search of FRIDAY, officers did discover 22 tie off bags of crack cocaine weighing 19.1 grams.

Assistant District Attorney Kurt Haas of the Street Crime Bureau handled the prosecution of both cases.
