Two Defendants Sentenced to State Prison for Narcotics Sale, Possession

ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that LUIS NAVARRO, 27, of Albany, HENRY ADAMS, 42, of Albany were each sentenced to State Prison before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

HENRY ADAMS was sentenced to 3 ½ years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision. On April 10, 2013, ADAMS pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance, a Class C Felony.

On August 1, 2012, the defendant was observed by members of the Albany Police Department selling crack cocaine on Clinton Avenue in the City of Albany.

Additionally, LUIS NAVARRO was sentenced to 7 years in State Prison followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision. On April 8, 2013, NAVARRO pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony.

On October 18, October 25 and October 29, 2012, NAVARRO was observed by members of the Albany Police Department selling heroin in the area of Madison Avenue and Knox Street in the City of Albany.

Pursuant to a search warrant, police entered the defendant's residence and discovered 98 bags of heroin, four digital scales and numerous glassine baggies commonly used to package heroin.

Assistant District Attorney Jasper Mills of the Street Crimes Bureau handled the prosecution of both cases.
