**Up to 5 Years in State Prison for Repeat Drunk Driver**  
***Defendant Has Been Convicted of Felony Driving While Intoxicated Four Times Since 2008***



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that PAUL ETZEL, 31, of Cohoes, was sentenced to 1 2/3 to 5 years in State Prison before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

On May 15, 2014, ETZEL pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Class D Felony.

On March 9, 2014 in the vicinity of Route 9 and Sparrowbush Road in the Town of Colonie, ETZEL was observed by members of the Colonie Police Department operating a motor vehicle with a broken headlight and initiated a traffic stop. Upon speaking with ETZEL, officers noticed multiple physical signs of intoxication and detected the odor of alcoholic beverage coming from his breath.

After removing ETZEL from the vehicle officers administered multiple field sobriety tests, which he failed. ETZEL was taken into custody and later refused to submit to a chemical test to determine his blood alcohol content.

At the time of his arrest, ETZEL was on Felony Probation stemming from his conviction on January 10, 2012 of (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Class D Felony, and on April 5, 2012 of (1) Count of Driving While Intoxicated, a Class E Felony.

In addition to the period of incarceration imposed by the Court, ETZEL must also pay a \$2,000 fine, install an ignition interlock device in any vehicle he owns for a period of 3 years following his release from custody and be subject to a minimum of 18 months of license revocation, subject to the Department of Motor Vehicles.

Vehicular Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Mary Tanner-Richter is handling the prosecution of this case.
