## Watervliet Man Sentenced to State Prison for Robbery of Chinese Food Delivery Man



**ALBANY, NY-** District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **DAMON MONGE**, 19, of Watervliet, was sentenced to 4 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On October 8, 2013, **DAMON MONGE** pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony.

On June 2, 2013, MONGE and co-defendant JONATHAN KING, 17, of Watervliet placed an order with a local Chinese food restaurant in the City of Watervliet. When the delivery man arrived at the residence with the food, MONGE struck him in the head and knocked him to the ground. KING then proceeded to steal money from the injured delivery man.

On October 29, 2013, JONATHAN KING pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court.

KING faces 3 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision when sentenced on December 10, 2013.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Legal Affairs Bureau is overseeing the prosecution of both of these cases.
