10 Year Sentence in Drug and Illegal Weapon Possession Case



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAYVON SOSTRE, 26, of Albany, was sentenced to 10 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On February 1, 2017, SOSTRE was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree, a Misdemeanor.

The jury found that on June 17, 2016, at approximately 7:12 P.M., members of the New York State Police conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle that was speeding on I-787 in the Village of Menands. Upon further inspection of the vehicle, SOSTRE was found to be in unlawful possession of a loaded .22 caliber pistol, as well as a quantity of cocaine.

General Felony Unit Bureau Chief Steven Sharp prosecuted this case.
