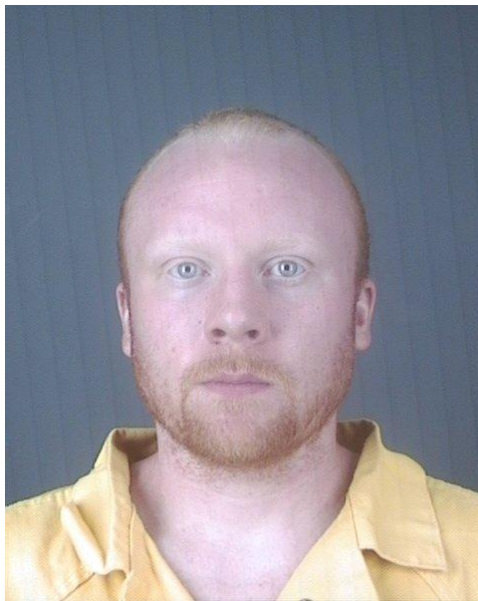

11 Years In State Prison for Robbery of Multiple Pharmacies



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that TIMOTHY O’CONNOR, 30, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Robbery in the First Degree, a Class C Felony, in full satisfaction of the indictment before the Honorable Thomas Breslin in Albany County Court this morning.

On September 6, 2012, O’CONNOR entered a CVS on Madison Avenue in City of Albany brandishing a claw style hammer and stole money from the register. On September 18, 2012, O’CONNOR returned to the CVS on Madison Avenue. O’CONNOR displayed a note stating he had a gun and demanded oxycodone from the pharmacist.

Finally, on September 19, 2012, O’CONNOR entered a Rite-Aid pharmacy on Central Avenue and handed a pharmacist a note stating he had a gun and displaying what appeared to be a pistol. O’CONNOR took a half ounce of oxycodone from this pharmacy.

O’CONNOR faces 11 years in State Prison followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on March 28, 2013.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Offense Bureau prosecuted this case.
