25 Year Sentence in Violent Albany Robbery Case

ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAQUIN MONTGOMERY, 27, of Albany, was sentenced to 25 Years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable William A. Carter in Albany County Court this morning.

MONTGOMERY was previously found guilty after a jury trial of (4) Counts of Robbery in the First Degree, each Class B Violent Felonies, and (2) Counts of Burglary in the Second Degree, each Class B Violent Felonies.

After hearing testimony and reviewing evidence presented at trial, the jury concluded that on

October 8, 2018, at approximately 8:30 P.M., MONTGOMERY, acting in concert with a co-defendant, unlawfully entered a residence on Washington Avenue in the City of Albany and forcibly stole property from (4) victims while displaying what appeared to be a pistol.

Co-defendant MARCELLE CHANDLER, 24, of Albany, previously pleaded guilty to the entire indictment and is currently scheduled to be sentenced on January 10, 2020 for his role in the crime.

Assistant District Attorney Michael Shanley of the Major Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
