25 Years to Life for Albany Murder



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JARQUELL

WILLIAMS, 28, of Albany, was sentenced to 25 Years to Life in State Prison before the Honorable Judge Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Court this morning for his role in an October 2014 murder in the City of Albany.

On October 2, 2015, WILLIAMS was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-I Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class C Armed Felony.

On October 16, 2014, at approximately 9:40 a.m. in the area of Bassett Street and South Pearl Street in the City of Albany, WILLIAMS did cause the death of a 25 year old male by means of shooting him in the head with a firearm.

WILLIAMS was also sentenced to 15 Years in State Prison for the Criminal Possession of a Weapon charge, to run concurrent with the murder sentence.

Financial Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Daniel Lynch and Street Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Eric Galarneau prosecuted this case.
