2 Year Prison Sentence for Assault on Police Officer



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DOMONEC TUCKER, 27, of Albany, was sentenced to 2 years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On January 15, 2015, TUCKER was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony.

On February 23, 2014 at approximately 4:00 a.m., in the vicinity of West Lawrence Street and

Spring Street in the City of Albany, officers from the Albany Police Department responded to a call for service. Upon the officers arrival they found TUCKER arguing with another individual. Officers then detained the other individual and questioned TUCKER about the reasons for the call. TUCKER refused to answer the questions, and when officers attempted to detain her for further questioning, she assaulted an officer, causing a laceration to the officer's face and an injury to his knee. TUCKER was then subdued and arrested.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
