7 Year Sentence for Violent Strangulation



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that SAM MANN, 63, of Albany, was sentenced to 7 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

On July 17, 2014, MANN pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Strangulation in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony.

On December 9, 2013 at a residence on Central Avenue in the City of Albany, MANN forcibly strangled an individual known to him by putting both of his hands around the victim's throat. He also punched the victim multiple times in the face and forced a sock down the victim's throat and shoved tissue up the victim's nose, causing the victim to lose consciousness.

Assistant District Attorney Jennifer McCanney of the Special Victims Unit prosecuted this case.
