Albany Burglar Sentenced To 7 Years In State Prison



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KAYAAN MARROW, 24, of Albany, was sentenced to 7 years in State Prison, followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision, in Albany County Supreme Court this morning. MARROW will also be required to pay restitution to the victim in the amount of \$2,325.

On November 13, 2012, MARROW pleaded guilty to (2) Counts of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, both Class D Violent Felonies, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick.

On June 18, 2012, MARROW burglarized a home in the City of Albany and stole a laptop and jewelry. On June 25, 2012, MARROW, along with Co-Defendant BRANDON JIMENEZ, 20, burglarized a home in the City of Albany. As they were entering the home, a police officer responded to the scene, and both MARROW and JIMENEZ fled. MARROW was apprehended a few blocks away, and JIMENEZ was later arrested on June 29, 2012.

On September 27, 2012, JIMENEZ pleaded guilty to (2) Counts of Attempted Burglary in the Second Degree, both Class D Violent Felonies, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick. On November 15, 2012, JIMENEZ was sentenced to 7 years in State Prison.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Legal Affairs Bureau prosecuted both cases.
