Albany Teen Pleads Guilty to Weapons Charges



Albany, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced that MARC DUDLEY, 17, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony before the Honorable Joseph Teresi in Albany County Court this morning.

On June 28, 2012, Albany Police responded to a 911 call regarding DUDLEY pointing a loaded gun at a female on Quail Street in the City of Albany. DUDLEY then entered into his residence on Quail Street. Police executed a search warrant for DUDLEY's residence and recovered a .22 caliber revolver in his bed room closet.

“Do you understand who you really hurt today with your actions? Your father first and then you,” commented Judge Teresi. DUDLEY’s father was standing next to him throughout the proceeding.

“Judge Teresi was right in his observation. Mr. Dudley should have been visiting college campuses with his dad today. Instead he has thrown his future away by his actions. Gun crimes will not be tolerated in Albany County,” commented DA Soares.

DUDLEY faces 2 years in State Prison followed by 3 years Post Release Supervision. DUDLEY will be sentenced on October 16, 2012.

Assistant District Attorney Dan Lynch of the Street Crimes Bureau handled the prosecution of this case.
