Case Resolutions for Illegal Weapons Possession

ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today two case resolutions for illegal weapons possession cases in Albany County Court.

KENYON MYERS, 30, of Schenectady, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class D Armed Felony, before the Honorable Roger McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On July 23, 2014, at approximately 6:25am, in the area Troy-Schenectady Road and Knadler Drive in the Town of Colonie, MYERS was riding as a passenger of a vehicle that was stopped for vehicle and traffic violations by Colonie Police Officers. Officers uncovered a loaded Cobra

.380 semi-automatic pistol under the passenger seat, which was determined to illegally be in MYERS' possession.

MYERS faces 4 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on July 24, 2015.

Additionally, ROBERT GRAHAM, 22, of Albany, was sentenced to 2 years in State Prison, to be followed by 1 ½ years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On January 14, 2015, GRAHAM pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class D Armed Felony.

On December 11, 2014, at approximately 7:35pm, members of the Albany Police Department responded to a report of an emotionally disturbed person who was standing in the middle of the road near the intersection of Putnam Street and Van Orden Street in the City of Albany. Police found GRAHAM at that location with a loaded Hi-Point CF 380 handgun in his pocket. The weapon had previously been reported stolen in Dillon County.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Street Crimes Unit is prosecuting these cases.
