## Co-Defendants Arraigned for Roles in Colonie Burglary

**ALBANY, NY** - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **RAYMOND HALACY**, 19, of Rensselaer and **ANDRE BEVERLY**, 18, of Colonie, each were arraigned on

(1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

The indictment alleges that on November 28, 2013 on Haswell Road in the Town of Colonie, RAYMOND HALACY, ANDRE BEVERLY, 18, and a third co-defendant JOHN HALACY, 24, of Rensselaer, unlawfully entered a residence and stole guitars, a television and various other electronic items while inside.

RAYMOND HALACY and ANDRE BEVERLY pleaded not guilty today and were remanded to Albany County Correctional Facility.

Prior to today's arraignment, RAYMOND HALACY and ANDRE BEVERLY were located by members of the U.S. Marshal Service in Florida and waived extradition back to New York State.

On December 11, 2013, JOHN HALACY was arraigned on (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Stephen Herrick in Albany County Court. HALACY pleaded not guilty and was remanded to the Albany County Correctional Facility without bail.

Bureau Chief Eric Galarneau of the Major Offense Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
