

Guilty Plea After Repo Men Find Gun in Car



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that ISAIAH ANDERSON, 29, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class D Armed Felony, before the Honorable Judge Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Court yesterday morning.

On January 17, 2015, at approximately 3:00 a.m., a private property repossession company collected a vehicle that was parked outside of a residence on Myrtle Avenue in the City of Albany. A routine inventory search of the car uncovered a loaded .380 Baretta handgun in plain

view in the center console. The company notified the Albany Police Department, who determined that the weapon was in the illegal possession of ANDERSON. ANDERSON cannot legally possess a firearm due to two previous felony convictions.

ANDERSON faces 5 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, when sentenced on May 14, 2015.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp of the Street Crimes Unit is prosecuting this case.
