## Guilty Plea For Unlawful Sexual Surveillance



**ALBANY, NY**- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that PATRICK KAISER, 54, of Canastota, New York, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Unlawful Surveillance in the First Degree as a Sexually Motivated Felony, a Class D Felony, before Honorable Joseph Teresi in Albany Supreme Court this morning.

On September 23, 2012, KAISER was observed by an off-duty police officer in a Colonie grocery store sticking his foot between a women's legs who was wearing a skirt when she was not paying attention. The women confronted KAISER, who fled the store, but was quickly apprehended. Police executed a search warrant of KAISER's vehicle and found a pen video camera, which contained several videos of undergarments of non-consenting females while they were not paying attention.

KAISER faces between 2 to 4 Years in State Prison when sentenced on December 11, 2012

Assistant District Attorney Brett Knowles of the Special Victims Unit prosecuted this case.
