Guilty Plea for Colonie Drug Den Dealer



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **GENEAMO BURTON**, 32, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, a Class B Felony, before the Honorable Steven Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On January 3, 2014, the Colonie Police initiated a traffic stop of **BURTON**'s vehicle on Central Avenue. **BURTON** was found to be in possession of 35 grams of cocaine. Police, along with members of the Drug Enforcement Agency, then executed a search warrant in **BURTON**'s apartment and uncovered an additional ten (10) ounces of cocaine, \$30,000 in cash, a cash counting machine, and over ten pounds of marijuana.

This plea also satisfies charges from December 18, 2013 and January 24, 2014 where BURTON did sell cocaine in the Town of Colonie.

BURTON faces 6 ½ years in State Prison, to be followed by 3 years of Post Release Supervision when sentenced on July 9, 2014. BURTON will also forfeit \$30,000 that was seized during arrest.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Street Crimes Unit is handling the prosecution of this case.
