Guilty Plea in Albany Knife Assault



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that KEVIN SECOR, 24, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the First Degree, a Class C Violent Felony, before the Honorable Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On May 22, 2017, at approximately 10:00 P.M., on Livingston Avenue in the City of Albany, SECOR did stab an adult male that was known to him with a knife. The victim was stabbed twice in the leg and twice in the stomach. SECOR attempted to flee the scene but was stopped by members of the Albany Police Department and taken into custody. The victim survived and was treated at an area hospital, sustaining serious medical problems as a result of this incident.

SECOR faces 10 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post Release Supervision, when sentenced on September 22, 2017.

Assistant District Attorney Joseph Brucato of the Major Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
