Guilty Verdict after Drug and Illegal Weapon Possession Case



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAYVON SOSTRE, 26, of Albany, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Seventh Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court today.

On June 17, 2016, at approximately 7:12 P.M., members of the New York State Police conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle that was speeding on I-787 in the Village of Menands. Upon further inspection of the vehicle, SOSTRE was found to be in unlawful possession of a loaded .22 caliber pistol, as well as a quantity of cocaine, and was placed into custody.

SOSTRE faces up to 15 years in State Prison when sentenced on March 29, 2017.

General Felony Unit Bureau Chief Steven Sharp prosecuted this case.
