



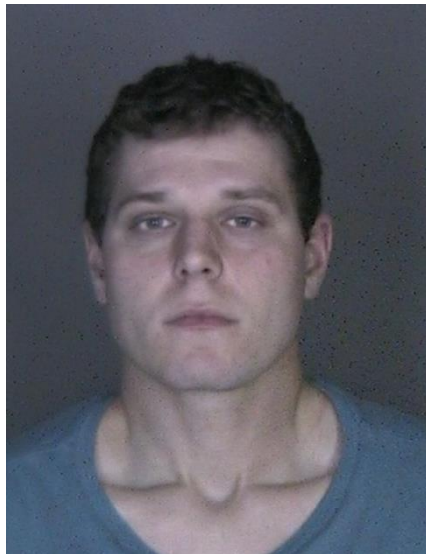

Guilty Verdict after Albany DWI Trial



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that MATTHEW DINGLEY, 27, of Wynantskill, was found guilty after a jury trial of (2) Counts of Driving While Intoxicated, both Misdemeanors, before the Honorable Judge John Reilly in Albany City Court yesterday afternoon.

On July 17, 2017, at approximately 8:06 p.m., members of the New York State Police responded to a motor vehicle crash involving two vehicles that had just exited I-787 via the Exit 5 ramp towards Rensselaer County. Troopers identified DINGLEY as the driver of the vehicle that caused the crash. DINGLEY displayed signs of intoxication, admitted to drinking three beers earlier that evening at an “Alive at Five” concert, and failed roadside field sobriety testing on the scene. DINGLEY later registered a blood alcohol content of .08%.

DINGLEY faces up to one year in custody when sentenced on April 12, 2019.

Assistant District Attorney Ryan Murphy handled the prosecution of this case.
