Guilty Verdict after Jury Trial for Repeat Felon



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DENNIS BOODROW, 57, of Albany, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Grand Larceny in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony, before the Honorable Judge Debora Young in Albany County Court this afternoon.

On January 22, 2016, at approximately 9:30 P.M., BOODROW knowingly stole a set of four tire rims from a Cadillac that was located at the Otto Cadillac dealership in 1730 Central Avenue in

the Town of Colonie. The theft was captured on surveillance video and BOODROW later confessed to police.

At the time of the incident BOODROW was serving a term of Felony probation stemming from a 2015 Felony DWI conviction.

The maximum sentence for a Class D Felony is usually 3 ½ - 7 years in State Prison. However, due to BOODROW's extensive criminal history including at least 5 felony convictions and 55 Misdemeanor convictions, the Court has the potential to designate BOODROW as a persistent felon, which carries the potential of up to Life in State Prison. BOODROW faces sentencing on July 20, 2017.

Assistant District Attorney Michael Shanley of the Vehicular Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
