Guilty Verdict after Jury Trial in Albany Burglary Case



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DAVID BROWN, 28, of Albany, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Burglary in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court in the afternoon of Friday, June 22, 2018.

After hearing testimony and reviewing evidence, the jury concluded that on June 24, 2017, at approximately 5:45 A.M., BROWN unlawfully entered an apartment on Ontario Street in the

City of Albany while residents were home and in their bedrooms. While inside BROWN stole a television. Video surveillance captured BROWN outside of the residence after the incident carrying a television while walking away.

BROWN faces up to 15 years in State Prison when sentenced on August 17, 2018.

Assistant District Attorney Collin D'Arcy of the General Felony Unit prosecuted this case.
