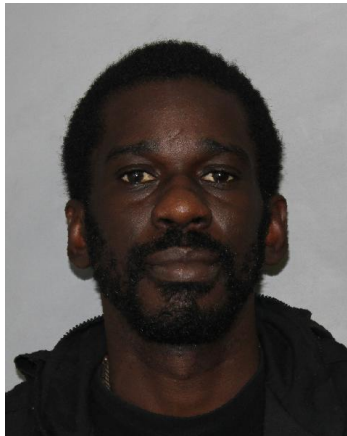

Guilty Verdict in Domestic Assault Case



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that HENRY MANIGAULT, 40, of Acra, NY, was found guilty after a jury trial of (3) Counts of Strangulation in the Second Degree, all Class D Felonies, (1) Count of Assault in the Third Degree, a Class D Felony, (1) Count of Unlawful Imprisonment in the Second Degree, a Class D Felony, and (1) Count of Rape in the Third Degree, a Class E Felony, before Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On November 6, 2013, while at a residence in the Town of Rensselaerville, MANIGAULT did intentionally physically assault, rape, and repeatedly strangle his then intimate partner.

MANIGAULT faces 7 years in State Prison when sentenced on January 26, 2014.

Assistant District Attorney Chantelle Cleary of the Special Victims Unit prosecuted this case.
