Identity Thief Sentenced to State Prison



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that RONICE SAHADEO, 35, of Albion, NY, was sentenced to 2 ½ to 5 Years in State Prison before the Honorable Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this morning.

On January 8, 2015, SAHADEO pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Identity Theft in the First Degree, a Class D Felony.

On September 19, 2014, SAHADEO fraudulently represented herself as another individual at the Capital Communications Federal Credit Union in the Town of Colonie. SAHADEO used personal information, including date of birth and social security number, of an individual and attempted to take out a personal loan in the amount of \$15,000.00. Bank personnel detected a discrepancy in the filed paperwork and notified law enforcement.

At the time of the incident SAHADEO was under the supervision of Parole stemming from a previous felony forgery related conviction.

Assistant District Attorney Philip Apruzzese of the Financial Crimes Unit handled the prosecution of this case.
