Man Found Guilty of Murder After Trial



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JARQUELL WILLIAMS, 28, of Albany, was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Counts of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-I Felony, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, a Class C Armed Felony, before the Honorable Judge Thomas A. Breslin in Albany County Court this afternoon.

On October 16, 2014, at approximately 9:40 a.m. in the area of Bassett Street and South Pearl Street in the City of Albany, WILLIAMS did cause the death of a 25 year old male by means of shooting him in the head with a firearm.

WILLIAMS faces up to 25 years to life in State Prison when he is sentenced on November 20, 2015.

Assistant District Attorneys Dan Lynch of the Financial Crimes Unit and Eric Galarneau of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
