Man Pleads Guilty to Attempting to Rob a Dunkin' Donuts



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that DEMONTE MILLER, 26, of Troy, pleaded guilty to Attempted Robbery in the 1st Degree, a Class C Felony, before the Honorable Judge Roger McDonough in Albany County Court this morning.

On September 28, 2014, MILLER conspired with a co-defendant to rob a Dunkin' Donuts employee at gunpoint of the store's daily bank deposit. The employee was driving to the bank to drop off the daily deposit and was stopped at a stoplight. MILLER pointed a pistol at the employee through his open driver's window and demanded that he give MILLER the bank deposit bag.

MILLER faces 14 years determinate in State Prison, to be followed by 5 Years of Post-Release Supervision, and must pay restitution in the amount of \$3,857 USD when he is sentenced on October 2, 2015.

Assistant District Attorney Linda Griggs of the Major Offense Unit is prosecuting this case.
