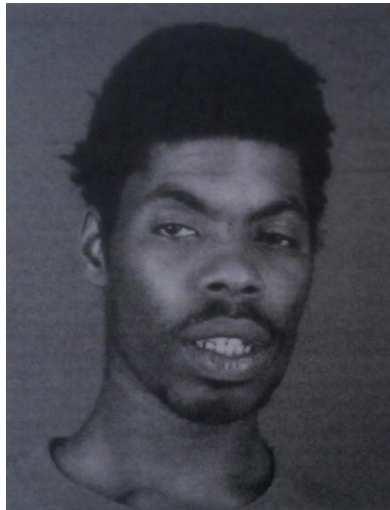

## Man Pleads Guilty to Stabbing Assault



**ALBANY, NY** – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that QUAVON GRIMES, 22, of Albany, pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Assault in the Second Degree, a Class D Violent Felony before Judge Thomas Lamont this morning in Albany County Court.

On June 10, 2012, at 12:10 a.m., GRIMES and the victim were involved in an argument on Second Avenue in the City of Albany. At some point the argument ended, GRIMES then left, retrieved a knife, and returned to Second Avenue, and lunged at the victim and stabbed the victim once in the stomach with the knife. GRIMES then fled toward Clinton Street but was apprehended. The victim was taken to Albany Medical Center and required surgery.

GRIMES faces up to 5 years in State Prison when sentenced on October 16, 2012.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Hauf of the Major Offenses Unit handled the prosecution of the case.
