Man Sentenced After Attacking Woman and Violating Order of Protection



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that JUSTIN CARGILL, 26, of Albany, was sentenced to 1-3 years indeterminate in State Prison before the Honorable Judge Thomas Breslin in Albany County Court this morning.

On September 4, 2015, CARGILL pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Criminal Contempt in the First Degree, a Class E Felony.

On the evening of April 4, 2015, in the area of 57 North Swam Street, in the City of Albany, CARGILL attacked a woman that was known to him. He applied pressure to her throat and attempted to strangle her. At this time, CARGILL was in violation of a No Contact Order of Protection that was in place.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Schrantz prosecuted this case.
