Man Sentenced for Shooting At Colonie Home



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **TERRENCE RAWLINSON**, 35, of Easton, PA, was sentenced to 13 years in State Prison to be followed by 5 years Post Release Supervision before the Honorable Judge Stephen W. Herrick in Albany County Court this morning.

On December 4, 2015, **RAWLINSON** was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the First Degree, and (1) Count of Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the Second Degree, both Class C Felonies.

On January 11, 2015, at around 9:22 p.m., police responded to calls for shots fired on Arcadia Court in the Town of Colonie. Officers from the Albany Police Department and Colonie Police Department identified a car leaving the scene being driven by **RAWLINSON**. Inside the vehicle police located an Iver Johnson .38-caliber revolver with a live round in the chamber, with four expended rounds in the cylinder.

RAWLINSON was found guilty of possessing the weapon found in the vehicle, in addition to attempting to cause serious physical injury to residents of the home, including two children, by firing the weapon at the house. Police recovered two of the bullets in the siding of the home.

Assistant District Attorney Steven Sharp handled the prosecution of this case.
