Man Sentenced for Attempted Assault



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **ANDRE MCCAULEY**, 30, of Guilderland, was sentenced to 12 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Judge Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Court this morning.

On April 22, 2015, MCCAULEY was found guilty after a jury trial of (1) Count of Attempted Assault in the First Degree, a Class C Felony.

On June 27, 2014, at approximately 3:00 p.m., in the area of 187 Bradford Street in the City of Albany, MCCAULEY did intentionally shoot a 26-year-old adult male that was known to him with a Remington 45 caliber automatic handgun with the intent to cause serious physical injury. Members of the Albany Police Department arrived at the scene and located a victim of a grazed gunshot wound. The victim was treated and survived the encounter.

Assistant District Attorney Steve Sharp of the Street Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
