Man Sentenced for Driving with Suspended License



ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today CAMERON GARDNER, 26, of Troy, was sentenced to 1 year in Albany County Jail before the Honorable Judge Peter A. Lynch in Albany County Court this Tuesday.

On January 23, 2015, GARDNER was operating a vehicle with an expired registration sticker. Guilderland Police then discovered that GARDNER's license was suspended due to a previous alcohol-related conviction. GARDNER was expected to be driving with an Ignition Interlock Device due to his past conviction but the vehicle he was driving at the time he was pulled over did not have one installed.

On March 26, 2015, GARDNER pleaded guilty to (1) County of Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the First Degree, a Class E Felony, and (1) Count of Circumvention of Interlock Ignition Device, a Class A Misdemeanor.

Assistant District Attorney David Szalda of the Vehicular Crimes Unit prosecuted this case.
