Man Sentenced to 25 Years in Violent Albany Domestic Assault



ALBANY, NY - District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that REGINALD GILL, 47, of Albany, was sentenced to 25 years in State Prison, to be followed by 5 years of Post-Release Supervision, before the Honorable Judge Roger D. McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

On November 7, 2016, GILL pleaded guilty to (1) Count of Assault in the First Degree, a Class B Violent Felony, and (2) Counts of Assault in the Second Degree, both Class D Violent Felonies.

On April 19, 2016, at a residence on Yates Street in the City of Albany, at approximately 8:45 p.m., GILL stabbed a woman that was known to him with a hunting knife. The victim's adult brother and 12 year old son came to her aid, but were both also stabbed by GILL during the assault.

After the attack GILL fled the apartment and later surrendered himself to police. All three victims were treated for their injuries and survived the attack.

Assistant District Attorney Matthew Schrantz of the Special Victims Unit prosecuted this case.
