Men Arraigned On Murder and Robbery Charges

ALBANY, NY- District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that BERNARD WHITE, 23, ANTWAN UPTEGROW, 35 and UQUAN BEAN, 21 were each arraigned this morning in Albany County Supreme Court before the Honorable Stephen Herrick.

All three men were arraigned on (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-1 Felony, (3) Counts of Robbery in the First Degree, all Class B Violent Felonies, and (1) Count of Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class C Violent Felony.

Additionally, SHAQUAN OLIVER, 22, was indicted for his role in the murder and will be arraigned on December 14, 2012 before Judge Herrick.

On September 13, 2012 at 9:30PM in the area near Ontario Street in the City of Albany, OLIVER, WHITE, UPTEGROW AND BEAN attempted to rob Alex Duncan, 35 in front of a neighborhood business. During the robbery attempt, Duncan was shot in the chest and later taken to Albany Medical Center where he was pronounced dead.

All four men face a life sentence in State Prison if convicted on all charges. The men remain in custody in Albany County Correctional Facility.

Street Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Francisco Calderon is prosecuting this case.
