Murder Arraignment for Watervliet Homicide



ALBANY, NY – District Attorney P. David Soares announced today that **MICHAEL J. FOX**, 49, of Watervliet, was arraigned on (1) Count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-1 Felony, and (1) Count of Attempted Murder in the Second Degree, a Class B Felony, before the Honorable Roger McDonough in Albany County Supreme Court this morning.

A Grand Jury previously returned an indictment alleging that on January 8, 2016, around 8:00 P.M., in the area of 4th Avenue in the City of Watervliet, FOX allegedly caused the death of his neighbor, 29 year old Brandon Sherwin, by means of shooting him with a shotgun and stabbing him. It is additionally alleged that FOX did attempt to cause the death of a female known to him

by means of shooting at her with a shotgun. The female victim was not injured during the alleged crime.

FOX pleaded not guilty to the charges today and was remanded into custody without bail.

Street Crimes Unit Bureau Chief Eric Galarneau and Assistant District Attorney Jasper Mills are handling the prosecution of this case.
